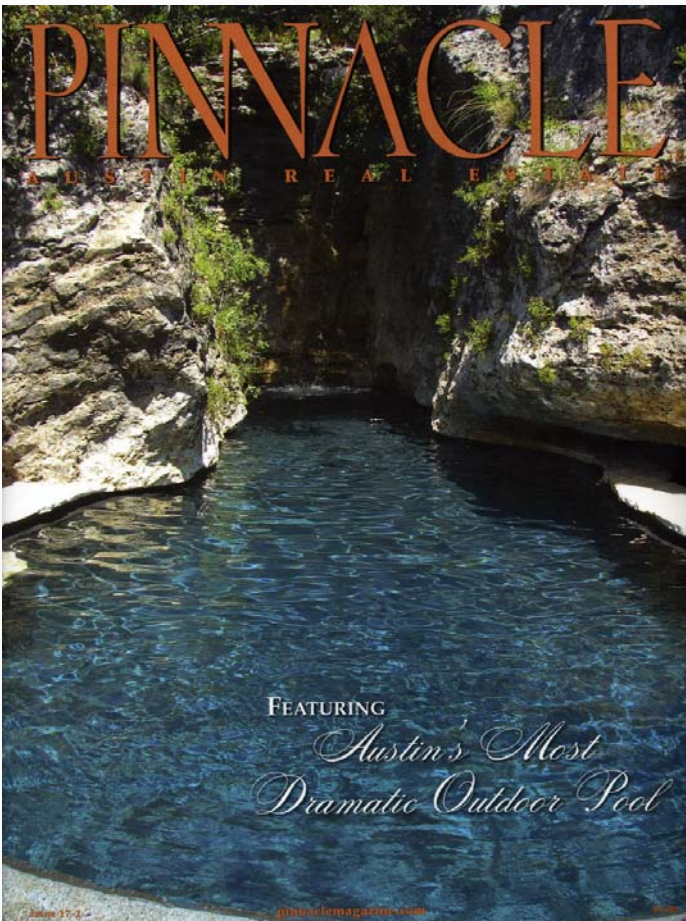

Lick Creek Ranch

Enjoy the peace, tranquility and harmony of Lick Creek Ranch, which is artistically situated on a secluded, 10-acre wooded peninsula overlooking the convergent point of where the Perdenales River and Lick Creek flow into Lake Travis. Nestled within the privacy of 43 acres are a five-bedroom, six- and one-half-bath main lodge, separate two-bedroom, two-bath guesthouse and stunning negative-edge pool with waterfall that has been sculpted into the natural crevices of surrounding rock cliffs. Each one is a unique example of how living in harmony with nature can be achieved. World-renowned architect John Culver Watson designed Lick Creek Ranch. As an apprentice of Frank Lloyd Wright, Watson mastered the art of blending new architecture into its natural surroundings. Frank Lloyd Wright wrote in his autobiography (1932): "No house should ever be on a hill or on anything. It should be of a hill, belonging to it, so hill and house could live each the happier for the other." Lick Creek Ranch is the essence of that philosophy brought to life and must be seen to be appreciated.
